



MBCC 2021-2022 Strategic Goals



GOAL 1

Support efforts to improve Criminal Justice Data collection and sharing across the state (2021-2023).

1. Partner with state legislative subcommittee and MT IT Board to assess data needs.
2. Meet with the Montana tribes to help improve Criminal Justice data collection and sharing.
3. Find funding opportunities to assist Criminal Justice data collection efforts.

GOAL 2

Enhance crime prevention and reduction activities to reduce crimes against persons, property and society.

1. Increase law enforcement activities by 5% per year.
2. Increase prevention initiatives by 10% per year.
3. Increase crime reduction initiatives by 10% per year.

GOAL 3

Provide opportunities and resources to strengthen and sustain victim services at the program and community level.

1. Increase access to potential funding by providing quarterly information regarding grant opportunities.
2. Increase knowledge of and access to trainings.
3. Improve funding priority and decision making through data collection and analysis and report to Board Members, partnering agencies, and subcommittees at least annually and prior to funding opportunities.

GOAL 4

To increase the capacity of jail alternatives by more than 15% through early intervention, pre-trial services, jail diversion programs, and Restorative Justice interventions by 2026.

1. Increase the number of individuals served by early intervention programs.
 2. Increase the number of beds available in sober living.
 3. Increase the percent of nonviolent offenders diverted.
 4. Increase the number of restorative programs conducted in correctional facilities and the community.
