Goal 1: Goal 1: Support efforts to improve Criminal Justice Data collection and sharing across the state.

1. Acquire and maintain necessary resources for data collection and justice data warehouse projects, including financial obligations from the legislature.
2. Research and develop funding opportunities to assist criminal justice data collection efforts.
3. Partner with local and state agencies, the courts, and community organizations to implement the justice data warehouse.
4. Effectively scale and properly resource a data collection plan statewide.
5. Report data-sharing efforts during the interim and in preparation for the 2027 legislature.

Goal 2: Support prevention and reduction of crime through education enforcement and interventions.

1. Dismantle and disrupt drug trafficking organizations (DTOs) through enforcement efforts, while advancing prevention and education initiatives.
2. Support prosecution and defense through funding and training.
3. Expand Youth-Focused Interventions, Prevention Programs, and Trauma-Informed Practices.
4. Expand adult intervention, prevention, and jail diversions.

Goal 3: Provide opportunities and resources to strengthen and sustain victim services at the program and community level.

1. Identify stakeholders for bi-annual stakeholder meetings.
 2. Convene stakeholders to collaboratively develop and update the state plan.
 3. Collect data and produce a comprehensive, annual victim services report, including tribes.
 4. Establish partnerships to support tribal and state initiatives for sharing victim services data and resources.
 5. Support strategies to sustain state-level funding for victim services in Montana.
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
